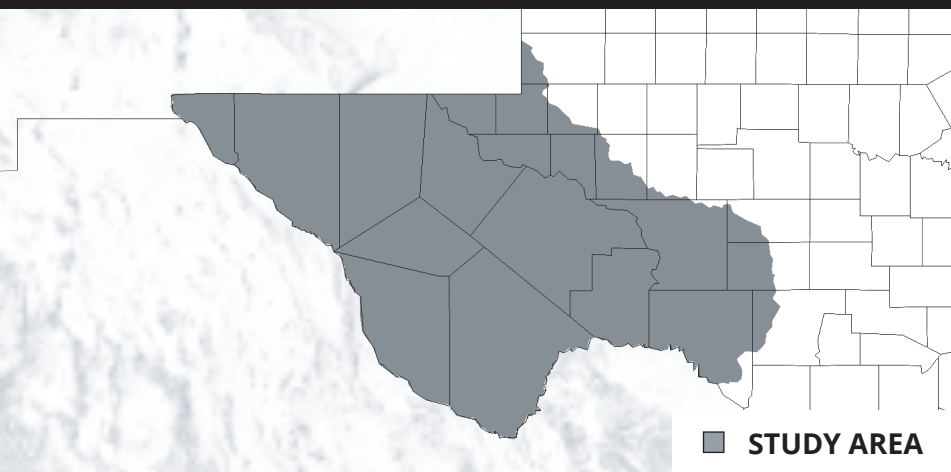


# PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE
